Maria Riccarda Wesseling is familiar with all the greatest theatres in Europe. The list of venues where she has performed includes the Théâtre des Champs-Élysées in Paris, the Opéra National de Paris, the Grand Théâtre in Geneva, the Théâtre National de la Monnaie in Brussels, the Berlin State Opera and the Concertgebouw in Amsterdam. With her emotional intensity, careful articulation and velvety mezzo timbre, this Swiss artist has made a deep impression on audiences and the music press. She has sung a number of Handel roles, including Rodrigo, Rinaldo, Giulio Cesare and Sesto, Dejanira in Hercules and Medea in Teseo (a Handel Festival performance, available on DVD from Arthaus).
